# **Château LANGLET Red 2020**

Graves Appellation Grand Vin de Bordeaux



## INTRODUCTION TO THE ESTATE

Situated in the commune of Cabanac-et-Villagrains, in the township of La Brède, the Château Langlet is one of the most ancient wines of the region. It is listed for its red and white wine production in the 1868 edition of "Bordeaux and its Wines", published by the Féret editions.

The vineyard is spread over a hill of deep gravel, with a magnificent position. It has been in the Jean Kressmann family since 1999, which has enforced a traditional winegrowing and winemaking culture in order to obtain the best from this exceptional terrain. The winery has obtained High Environmental Value (HEV) certification in 2019.

The color of Château Langlet red 2020 is intense with a purple sheen. Its nose is defined by aromas of black and red fruits, such as blackberry and cherry. On the palate, we discover a beautiful roundness, a smoothness around ripe fruits, sprinkled with delicate notes of spices and licorice. To be consumed within 5 to 8 years.
